1. SITUATION/BACKGROUND

The purpose of this report is to provide a summary of the services in escalation (as reported within the Directors Commissioning Team reports) under the NHS Wales Joint Commissioning Committee (JCC) escalation framework that are level 3 or above. Deescalated services will also be reported.

The escalation summaries are attached as **Appendix 1** to this document.

A copy of the escalation summaries will accompany the Sub-Committee Chairs report to the JCC. The expectation will that the summary reports will be shared within the Health Boards to gain assurance on commissioned services or any remedial actions required.

2. SPECIFIC MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION

JCC scrutinises the following sources of evidence and where concerns are identified the escalation process is triggered:

- Performance monitoring: This includes data such as Referral to Treatment Times (RTT), and maintenance of cancer treatment targets.
- Routine process indicators: This includes length of stay and delayed transfers of care.
- Routine outcome indicators: These will vary from specialty to specialty but might include mortality indicators, complication rates etc.
- Patient reported outcomes and experience;
- Clinical incidents: these might include incidents related to individual patients or to units such as infection outbreaks;
- Complaints or claims;
- Reviews undertaken either internally by providers or by external agencies such as CQC or HIW;
- Notification of service disruption;
- Failure to deliver services in line with the commissioning intentions; and
- Any other sources of concern.

JCC currently have 2 services in escalation at level 3 and one service that has been de-escalated to Level 1. There is also one service that will come out of the escalation process and that specific provider will be de commissioned.

3. KEY RISKS / MATTERS FOR ESCALATION

The following table provides a summary of each of those services outlining the mitigating actions and risks. These will have been discussed in full in the presentation of the Directors reports in previous sections of the agenda. A copy of the escalation summaries will accompany the Sun-Committee Chairs report to the JCC.
